Irrigation development in the State was initially being looked after by the Rural Development Department till 1986 and Irrigation and Flood Control Department was created only in 1986 and since the department has been solely responsible for providing Minor Irrigation, River Training, Jhora Training, Anti-Erosion Works etc. Later on the Department of irrigation & Flood Control has been entrusted with the sole responsibilities as per allocation of Business Rules 1994, with the objectives to shoulder the responsibilities as under:

- i). Development of Water Resources
- ii). Construction of Minor Irrigation Channel
- iii). Maintenance of Irrigation Schemes
- iv). Water management and Water Conservation as a Nodal Department for clearance of schemes relating to river or reservoir works.
- v). Assessment of Irrigation and Irrigation Development
- vi). Flood Control and Anti-Erosion Works, including Management and control of drainage and Jhora Training Works.

ALLOCATION OF BUSINESS:

The details of works looked after as per allocation of Business Rules, Government of Sikkim are as under:

- I. Survey, Investigation, Planning & Design, Estimation, Execution & Maintenance of:
 - a). MINOR IRRIGATION SCHEMES
 - i. Minor Irrigation Schemes all over the State.
 - ii. Command Area Development (Integrated Development of Agriculture through Irrigation facilities)
 - b). FLOOD CONTROL AND DRAINAGE
 - i). Flood Control, River Training & Anti-Erosion Schemes
 - ii). Jhora Training Works
 - c). GENERAL
 - i). Preparation of Drawing and estimates including supervision of restoration of Jhora Training & Anti-Erosion Works for land Revenue & Disaster Management Department
 - ii). Store of the Department for proper storage and accounting of constructional materials.

ADMINISTRATIVE SET-UP

The Irrigation & Flood Control Department was headed by the Chief Engineer-cum-Secretary and was assisted by the Additional Chief Engineer, Superintending Engineers, Divisional Engineers and Assistant Engineers of various Divisions & Sub-Divisions. Joint Secretary and sub-ordinates assist in all Administrative matters and Accounts Officers in Accounts matters. Deputy Director (M&E) to assist for monitoring, evaluation and for collection and compilation of data relating to irrigation and other related works.
