( I ) **Particulars of the Organization, its functions and duties.**

Name and address.

Ecclesiastical Affairs Department  
Government of Sikkim,  
Gangtok, Sikkim.

**Functions and duties.**

This is a unique Department which looks after religious matters in the State. All the religious institutions within the State of Sikkim like Buddhist monasteries, Hindu Mandirs, Christian Churches, Sai Mandirs, Sikh Gurdwaras, Limboo Manghims, Rai Mangkhims and Muslim Mosques come under this Department. This Department gives financial assistance to these religious institutions normally in the form of grants in aids, and also give limited financial help for organizing pujas. All the holy lakes, caves, rocks and mountain peaks come under the control of this Department. This Department also organizes religious functions and seminars during special cases. It runs Monastic Schools in Buddhist monasteries and Sanskrit Pathshalas attached to Hindu Mandirs to make the young monks or novices aware of the modern education like Science, English and Maths. The Department also gives permissions to shoot video/photo coverages of religious functions, donation collections, NOCs for Committee or land registrations of religious institutions, letter of introductions for carrying religious articles to or from Sikkim. Ecclesiastical Affairs Department is one of the oldest Departments of the State and hence it is unique Department that is found only in Sikkim.

(II) **Powers and duties of its Officers and employees.**

The Department of Ecclesiastical Affairs is manned by 10 Officers and 35 staff members. Hon'ble Chief Minister is the Minister-In-Charge supported by the Principal Secretary. We have one Special Secretary, one Additional Secretary, one Joint Secretary, one Joint Director, one Senior Gendrung, two Under Secretaries and one Deputy Director who are all Gazetted Officers.

Regarding the powers and duties of the Officers the Principal Secretary as Head of the Department is the overall Head of the Department who is supported by the Special Secretary in his capacity as Head of the Office. The Additional Secretary looks after the matters related with administration works supported by the Joint Secretary who is also the Drawing and Disbursing Officer. The Joint Director and the Senior Gendrung take care of the Directorate of Monastic Schools and Sanskrit Pathshalas that are attached with Buddhist monasteries and Hindu Mandirs. The Under Secretary – I is assigned field work duties of inspecting religious institutions spread throughout the State. The Under Secretary – II assists the general administration of the Department. She also assists the Additional Secretary in handling the matters related with Right to Information Act, 2005. And the Deputy Director is posted to Bodhgaya, Bihar to take care of the Sikkim Temple – Cum – Guest House.

Apart from the above mentioned Gazetted officers there are various other staff members who are working together as a family for carrying out the Departmental works. The Office Superintendent handles all the personal files, stationery files, updates various records and also does overall supervision. There are two Inspectors (Adhoc) who inspect various places related to this Department. Inspector – I looks after the matters that are related with North and East Sikkim whereas, the Inspector – II looks after the matters that are related with South and West. The U.D.C. puts up the applications received from public for matters like financial aids. The L.D.C / Typist handles the typing works, L.D.C / R.K. maintains up to date records of the Departmental files and also does typing works assigned by various officers and staff. The L.D.C (Dispatch) mainly handles the receiving of letters and dispatch works. The Private Secretaries attached to the Principal Secretary and the P.A. attached to the Special Secretary handle the typing works assigned to them.

However, during special functions or occasions all the officers and the staff of this Department work together as a team to produce a collective result. This Department does not have any branch office in the districts due to shortage of man-power. As such all the officers right upto the Principal Secretary are touring officers for inspections or spot verifications of religious institutions that are located at districts or villages and to take necessary action as and when required on the basis of public requests or orders from higher authorities. Things like organizing Kamsel ceremony at Tholung monastery, North Sikkim, conducting Bhumchu festival at Tashiding monastery, organizing of Nyingma Monlam at Bodhgaya and the like are some of the regular functions that are being exclusively carried out by this Department.

**(iii) The procedure followed in the decision making process.**

There is no fixed procedure in the decision making process for this Department. However, whenever such a case is required to be decided the Department gives decisions according to the nature of the situation at hand. Regarding minor things an application is to be put up from the LDC level through the hands of the concerned officers for taking decisions by the competent authorities and take necessary action according to the order given. In the case of major decisions the matter is submitted to the Government authorities like Chief Secretary or the Hon'ble Chief Minister and actions are taken as per the orders received thereafter. Sometimes decisions are taken during the meetings organized for special occasions. If needed in case of certain major works matter has to be sent to the Cabinet for the purpose of Cabinet Approval.

**(iv) The norms set by it for the discharge of its functions.**

The officers and staff of this Department discharge their functions as per the rules, orders, circulations and the like set by the Government from time to time. Or as and when orders and instructions received from authorities concerned.

**(v) The rules, regulations, instructions, manuals and records held by it or under its control or used by its employees for discharging its functions.**

The Officers and the staff of this Department discharge their functions according to the records of Government Rules, Regulations, Instructions and the Manuals that are being received by this Department from various other Departments and being maintained by the Record section.

**(vi) Statement of the categories of documents that are held by it or under its control.**

The files of this department are maintained according to the district - wise category.

**(vii) The particulars of any arrangement that exists for construction with, or representation by the members of the public in relation to the formulation of its policy or implementation thereof.**

This Department has no record of such arrangements so far.

The Government has constituted a Committee known as Ecclesiastical Committee vide Notification No.52/HOME/98 dated 24/9/98 to examine the documents and backgrounds of all the monasteries and other religious places of worship including important historical monuments and sacred lakes in Sikkim. Yes, they are open to the public. Notification attached at Annexure – I.
