Certificate of Appreciation

Mr. L.P.Sharma joined National Informatics Center, Sikkim State unit in 1993 as scientific officer and was posted to district units of NIC at east district and later to north district as District Informatics Officer. He vigorously worked to bring awareness of Information Technology among the district level officials. He designed, developed, demonstrated and implemented number of software applications for the district administrations.

In 2001 he conceived, developed and launched a technology product called '*Block Level Information System*' for north Sikkim. Later, same year, he documented a proposal titled "*Integrated Database Development Plan for Sustainable Socio Economic Development in Sikkim*" and presented to Government of Sikkim. In 2002 he launched a multimedia dynamic website for north district administration making north district a pioneer district in Sikkim to occupy a place in world wide web. The same year the website was nominated for the national e-governance award. He also worked hard for the establishment and maintenance of Community Information Centers in various parts of north district. With his hardworking and persuasive endeavor, the Community Information Centers located in sparsely populated areas of North Sikkim were listed among the top performing centers in the entire North East.

With sound knowledge of both technology as well as the subject domain he was also a crucial member of the Sikkim Land Record Software development team. His technical paper on Sikkim Land Record Computerization was awarded with **best technical paper award** during the 4th International Conference on E-governance in 2006 held at IIT Delhi. His technical paper titled "*Technology fusion for Land Record*" was also selected for presentation at eAsia 2007 held at Putrajaya, Malaysia. In 2005 he was transferred to Geo-Informatics Cell at NIC Sikkim State Unit, Gangtok, as Principal System Analyst and since then he is pioneering on Geographical Information System, Global Positioning System and Remote Sensing Technology as a tool for micro and macro level planning, and analyzing socio- economic status of the state. His latest work has been on GIS based Landslide Vulnerability Study and zonation, which he has completed for east district of Sikkim. He is also state technical coordinator for New Land Record Modernization Programme, Citizens Unique Id Project and Integrated Disease Surveillance Project.
