## District Diary

### Workshop on child rights and child related legislations held

**Mangan, November 13:** The Block level workshop on child rights and child related legislations was held at Mangan DAC for members of Village level Child Protection Committees of Mangan, today. This was the first coordination meeting of Block Level Child Protection Committee (BLCPC) and Village Child Protection Committees (VLCPCs) of Mangan in the North district.

The programme was held to sensitize the members of the Committees on child related legislations like JJ Act, 2015, POCSO (Amendment) Act, 2019, etc.

SDPO (Mangan), Mr. Tseten Palzor Bhutia explained about the role of police in protecting children and said that Mangan now has Special Juvenile Police Unit which is always there to protect children. He also explained about the formal procedure of reporting of case related to child abuse and exploitation to the Police.

The Chairperson, Child Welfare Commission (North), Mrs. Mingma Doma Bhutia

emphasised on the role of Child Welfare Committee as per Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 and requested the BLCPCs and VLCPCs to produce any child in need of care and protection before CWC and to report any case so that they can be assisted in funding justice. She said that the children can be produced to the CWC through the Police, NGOs, Doctors and Nurses or by calling Childline number 1098.

District Child Protection Officer (North), Mrs. Wendy Lepcha talked about the role which community can play in rendering services to Children in Need of Care and Protection (CNCP) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL).

It was informed that the main purpose of the Village Level Child Protection Committee (VLCPC) was to protect, monitor and address the issues of violation of child rights in the rural areas.

She also urged the Panchayats to spread awareness about children's rights and talked about abuse and exploitation.

She also called the students to spread awareness to their fellow students.

BDO (Mangan), Mr. D.S. Subba, gave a concise data on Children in Need of Care and Protection.

Block Level Child Protection Committee, Chairperson (Mangan), Mr. Mark Tshering Lepcha told the stakeholders to shield children from abuse and exploitations. He also insisted that child sexual abuse should be brought down to zero percent through persistent sensitization programmes.

During the same programme, Additional District Collector (North), Mr. Surat Gurung spoke on e-waste and said that Panchayats can play big role in villages to make people aware about segregation of e-waste management. He appealed to the Panchayats to keep e-waste dustbins in their respective areas which will help in recycling electronic wastes.

## Tourism and Civil Aviation Deptt. chairs meeting

**Gangtok, November 12:** A meeting was called by the Department of Tourism and Civil Aviation at a local hotel in the capital, today. The meeting was about conceptualizing the Film and TV Industry's spurt in the State and was chaired by ACS Tourism and Civil Aviation Department Dr. K. Jaykumar.

Limited, Mr. Arijit Dutta, Mr. Kailash Agarwal from Chamber of Commerce, Deputy Director, IPR, Mr. Bishal Khawas and representatives from the film fraternity of Sikkim.

In-order to bring about the holistic development in the Film Industry of Sikkim, areas related to establishment of Film & Television Institute, Miniplexes, organization of Film Festivals and establishment of Project Office were discussed and endorsed for putting up the proposal to the Government.

Additionally, 12 states including Sikkim along with esteemed institutes like Wildlife Institute of India and Indian Institute of Forest Management will also discuss and share their knowledge, experiences and success stories in order to address the multifaceted complexities of the growing and intensifying conservation challenges.

Principal Secretary/PCCF, Mr. Srivastava, in his address, informed that JICA assisted Sikkim Biodiversity Conservation & Forest Management Project (SBFP) under FE&WM Department is holding the workshop for its commitment

towards biodiversity conservation while also involving local people for strengthening inclusive management.

Highlighting on various activities factored in the State of Sikkim under JICA, Mr. Srivastava stated that the basic objective is biodiversity conservation by means of strengthening the forest management capacity, infrastructure building, conducting scientific studies and researches while simultaneously improving the livelihood of the local people who are forest dependent.

Expressing concern over important issues envisaging crop raiding incidences by wild pig, Indian Peafowl, Porcupine and Civet Cat, monkey menace and bear attacks leading to casualties, he stated that experts, specialists and senior officials have been invited for the three-daylong workshop in order to discuss, debate and discover the means to mitigate these issues of human-wildlife conflict.
